



From Clinic to Course: Joellyn Fox Runs Boston

For more than 17 years, physical therapist **Joellyn Fox** has dedicated her career at Penn Medicine’s Movement Disorder Center to helping people with Parkinson’s disease stay strong through exercise, movement and connection. In 2025, she took that commitment to the Boston Marathon as a first-time Team Fox runner. Inspired by her patients — whom she calls “the true marathoners” for their resilience — Joellyn ran in memory of her father, who introduced her to running and encouraged her passions. With the support of her patients and colleagues, she became the team’s top fundraiser, raising over \$63,000. For Joellyn, crossing the finish line was both a tribute to her father and a celebration of the strength she sees in her patients every day.
