In 2019, the *Parkinson's IQ* + *You* series was launched with the goal of bringing over 5,000 members of the Parkinson's community together over the course of seven events.

We know face-to-face communication instills a true sense of community and credibility through the ability to interact and socialize. After the events were paused in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID-19, with the re-launch in 2022 we've seen just how eager our community is to get back to face-to-face connection. We are thrilled to continue building on this momentum with four in-person events in 2024 in major markets across the U.S.

Educate and Grow an Informed Population



Program content with clear calls to action*, distributed within the Parkinson's Partner Expo and plenary sessions, increases the number of people aware of PD symptoms and encourages more people with Parkinson's and care partners to ask questions to their/their loved one's doctors about available treatments and research opportunities.

Parkinson's Partner Expo members will have the opportunity to disseminate critical information and resources for patients and care partners**. This knowledge is relevant to attendees, as well as local groups participating in the expo such as: movement disorder and research centers, advocacy and community organizations, support groups and allied healthcare providers.

Feedback solicited through a post-event survey from Chicago suggest participants view the Partner Expo as a valuable place to learn about new treatment options and research opportunities:

90% of attendees reported learnings about **treatment options for a variety of PD symptoms** at the expo

93% of attendees reported learnings about ways to participate in research at the expo

42% of attendees reported finding a **new exercise or support group** at the expo
