For 10 years, **Poker for Parkinson's** has brought energy and purpose to Dreamforce week in San Francisco. Hosted by longtime Team Fox member **Rich Kline**, the annual tournament began in 2016 after his father was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease. Drawing on his background as a former Salesforce employee, Rich rallied his professional community to turn a love of poker into meaningful impact. Each year, nearly 150 players and supporters gather for a lively evening of cards and camaraderie, competing for prizes Rich secures while raising funds for research.
